


Read Ephesians 4:1-6

Communion

Choose one person (maybe from our fellowship) – let them know you're praying for them this week Heavenly Father

We thank you that you have not asked us to be alone as believers but have made us part of your world-wide church. We're called to share joys and suffering; to acknowledge doubts and fears; to support and build each other up both practically and in prayer; to forgive and be forgiven; and to work for the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.
